Adjective /Adverb	When one thing is directly compared to another thing	'Blue' / 'humongous' / 'soft'	
Five senses (smell/ see/ taste/ touch and hear)	Words that describe objects (nouns) / Words that describe verbs	'I could smell freshly baked bread wafting from the kitchen, and the sweet fragrance of laundry filling the air.'	
Simile	When a number of words have the same first consonant sound	'The walls are painted as white as snow.'	
Metaphor	We use these five sense to experience the world around us	'A man's house is his castle.'	
Personification	When one thing is compared to another using 'like' or 'as'	'The water in the pool appeared to wink at you in the sun.'	
Alliteration	When an object is made to sound like a human	'There is a soft blue baby teddy on the beautiful bed.'
