


INSTRUCTIONS: Read the following information. Then answer the two questions below.

Pearl Harbour

“The U.S. Navy was heavily damaged. Nearly 20 ships were sunk or damaged. But only three were never recovered: the USS Arizona, the Utah, and Oklahoma. All of the other ships were repaired and returned to duty during the war.



Today, there is a memorial located in Pearl Harbor in honor of the events that happened that day. The World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument floats above the sunken USS Arizona, which lost the largest number of lives when it sank. More than 1,100 sailors and Marines died inside the battleship. The monument is considered an active American military cemetery and is free to visitors.”
