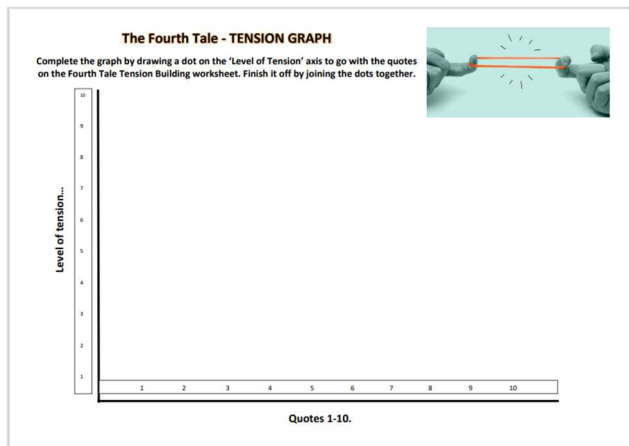


# The Fourth Tale.
